Unashamed Study #3 Romans 1:7-15

1. Recap from Romans 1:1-7 what we learn about the gospel message. Is there anything in the content of the message itself which means that everyone should hear it?
2. Take a look at Paul's travel plans in Romans 1:8-15 and Romans 15:17-32. Can you piece together Paul's intended itinerary? From these, what do you discern about Paul's priorities? What will help us to make these priorities our priorities? By the way, Paul did make it to Rome (under guard- Acts 28), but not necessarily further west to Spain.
3. How does Romans 16:25-27 make the same main point as the sermon (NB "establish" is the same word as "make strong" used in 1:11). Why do Christians need the gospel (rather than moving on to an alternative/deeper message)?
4. What/who has God used in your life lately to make some aspect of the gospel more real and wonderful to you?
5. Can you list a few practical ways you can strengthen other Christians by the gospel? Which one of these can you put into practice over the next week?
