
Dig Deeper into Romans 1:14-17 for personal use and Life Groups...

- 1. Can you list some of the reasons why sharing our faith/speaking about Jesus can be so difficult? Do you think that every follower of Jesus should be a spokesperson for Jesus? Is there help in Jesus' responses in Luke 9:57-62?
- 2. How would you describe Paul's attitude to sharing the gospel in Romans 1v8-17? Can you review from the verses what it is about the good news that makes Paul so keen to share it with people?
- 3. "We won't ever share the good news until we see that it is good news!" Can you explain why it is such good news? Is there anything about the message that you find difficult to take, or difficult to understand that you need help with?
- 4. Spend some time sharing the names of individuals who you would love to see discover the wonderful good news about Jesus? What is their next step? You might like to think about where on the "Great Commission Grid" they are, (discussed in week 1 below), and how you can help them onwards. Make sure you leave time to pray for them!
