- 1. Why do you think suffering is a mark of true Christian ministry (v24-25, 29)? How do we suffer for the gospel without burning out?
- 2. How could you explain to a friend v27: "Christ in you, the hope of glory"? In what sense is this a mystery?
- 3. For each of the aspects of Christian maturity in the verses...
  - a. what do they look like in practice?
  - b. why would they be great to have in increasing measure?
  - c. how do we get them?
- 4. What ministry or outreach opportunities do you have at the moment? Which aspect do you most need to take away from this passage?
