

**Dig Deeper into Colossians 2:9-15 for personal study and lifegroups...**

**Col 2:9-15 More?**

**What more do you need than Jesus, who gives us...**

	<b>... <u>complete</u> access to God</b> (v9-10)		<b>... a <u>complete</u> new start</b> (v11-13a)
	<b>... a <u>complete</u> cancellation of charges</b> (v13b-14)		<b>... a <u>complete</u> victory over all powers</b> (v15)



**→ Hunger for more 'of' Jesus,  
not more 'beyond' Jesus!**



**A few questions to dig deeper into the passage and its meaning and application...**

- Recap v6-8. How do these verses sum up the message of Colossians?
- Take one of these four ways in which Jesus brings “fulness” and think about
  - in what sense Jesus is “enough”?
  - when do you doubt this?
  - what do you need to tell yourself (and how can you do that)?
- What would you say is the difference between wanting “more of Jesus”, and wanting “more beyond Jesus”? Can you think of ways in which you have sought some sort of “top-up” additional to Jesus’ work in the past or present?

**Spend some time praising Jesus for his “supremacy” and “sufficiency”!**
