- 5. How should we respond to this story? What can we do to take practical steps for those who are vulnerable, and is this we should be doing as Christians or simply as good people?

The questions here are deliberately open with the aim to enable the group to respond with personal reflections and with the opportunity to respond with illustrations based upon personal experience.

V23 does not relate to any prophecy we have in the Old Testament and is thought to relate to Jewish oral history which Matthews target readers would understand.
