
## Dig Deeper into Hebrews 2:1-4 for personal study and lifegroups...



## A few questions from our concluding passage in this Hebrews 1-2 miniseries...

1) Looking back over this section as a whole (Hebrews 1:1-2:4), what would you say are the big lessons that the readers needed to learn? Which of these is most relevant to you right now?

2) Charlie picked out three words (in capitals above) to describe the message in and from Jesus (from 2:1-4). Do you agree with those? Are there other words that you would want to add to describe the message of Jesus?

3) What activities and influences are likely to make us drift? And what activities and influences help you to pay attention to Jesus? Can you think of one practical resolution to help you this Easter time?

4) OPTIONAL... We had a number of questions after Sunday's sermons about whether a Christian can fall away. How would you answer that question from the following pairs of passages from Hebrews...

- 1. Heb 3:12-13 and Heb 3:14
- 2. Heb 6:4-8 and Heb 6:9
- 3. Heb 10:38 and Heb 10:39.
