Dig Deeper 16/5/21 – Acts 9:1-31

GOD TRIUMPHS

- 1) Saul is stopped (v1-9)
- 2) Saul is converted (v10-19)
- 3) Saul is sent (v20-31)

<u>SO...</u>

Head – Believe that He is in control and can save anyone

Heart – Rejoice that He was in control when He saved you

Hands – Get involved with His mission
