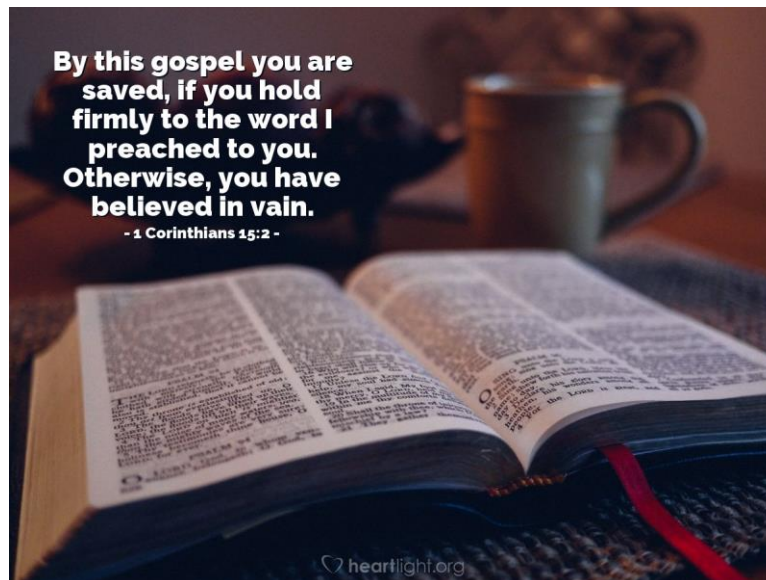


Dig Deeper Questions on Sharing our faith...



On Sunday John Henson shared some thoughts from 1 Tim 2:1-6 and James 5:19-20 and in the context of some powerful stories gave us the following top tips for sharing the good news...

1. *Share your testimony.*
2. *Pray with people.*
3. *Go back for a "return visit".*
4. *Two Questions you can ask...*
 - a. *If you died tonight would you be sure to go to heaven?*
 - b. *If you died tonight and God asked you why he should let you into heaven how would you respond?*
5. *Be confident to share the gospel for it is still the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes (Romans 1:16).*

Here are some questions for lifegroups and for personal study...

1. What truths does 1 Tim 2:1-6 contain that give us confidence to share our faith?
2. How does James 5:19-20 motivate us to bring people a) back to faith, b) to faith for the first time? Are there any individuals in your life at the moment who you are praying God might use you to help?
3. Looking at top tips 1-3 above does anyone spring to mind who you want to reach out to?
4. What are the two questions (see 4 above) intended to address? How do they get to the heart of the gospel? How would you answer them? How could you use them?
5. What can you do to have more confidence in the gospel for yourself and for others?
