- 2. Does it feel a little harsh that Gabriel struck Zechariah dumb for him doubting such a surprising message? Read 1:20 and 1:38 as part of your answer.
- 3. What does the story tell you about the reliability of God's word? How does this fit with what we saw last time from Luke 1:1-4? Which parts of God's revelation do we most struggle with? How does this passage help us?
- 4. Zechariah was a priest. Matt reminded us that his main roles would have been a) offering sacrifices, b) praying for people, c) speaking God's blessing. Have a look at these verses and then discuss how we **need** a priest, and how we can **be** faithful priests....
 - a. Hebrews 4:14-16
 - b. 1 Peter 1:9-10
 - c. Revelation 1:5b-6
