


Psalm 119 Dig Deeper Questions for personal reading and Life Groups...



On Sunday Jon taught all ages to Love God's Law (Psalm 119:97). His points were:

- 1) Love God's law
 - 2) because of how amazing it is
 - 3) by praising, meditating and obeying
1. **Getting into Psalm 119...** Each member of the group (or with a neighbour) pick a different 8-verse section from the Psalm (they are divided up according to the Hebrew alphabet because each verse starts with the same letter!)
 - a. Read through your section and look for any "word/command" words.
 - b. Do you see anything about "Bible Delight" (loving God's law)?
 - c. Share your thoughts and your favourite verse back to the group.
 2. **Application Questions**
 - a. How much do you love God's word? What things get in the way of you wholeheartedly loving God's word?
 - b. Look at the different descriptions of what God's word does. Where have we experienced these things? Eg God's word being a light to our path, or bringing us joy? How do these descriptions help us to love God's word more?
 - c. How can we meditate on God's word more effectively?
 - d. Where do we need to be increasing our obedience to God's word? What can help us with this?
