Incredible Faith

We see a number of aspects of faith in this passage. Pick a couple of them, and think about these questions:

- a) How did Ruth/Boaz display this aspect of faith
- b) How does Jesus display this aspect of faith
- c) How can you display this aspect of faith this week/month?

Suggested aspects of Incredible Faith...

- denies oneself (v5-6)
- is vulnerable (v7)
- doesn't take advantage (v10)
- obeys God despite the cost (v11, 12a)
- submits to God's laws fully (v12b)
- is intentional and expedient (v13, 14)

Feel free to choose another aspect that you have seen that was not mentioned!

Abundant Grace

- Where do we see grace given above and beyond?
- Whose 'hesed' love are we pointed to in this account?
- (hesed means a steadfast loving-kindness, often within a covenant)
- To whom are you able to show 'hesed' love?
- When loving others comes with a cost (which is nearly always!), how can this passage (and others) help you to continue loving them?

<u>Jesus</u>

- What things in this passage point you to Jesus?
- Select 3 things that you want to treasure about Jesus to help you marvel at him (not limited to things already said!)
- This week, how can you help someone else in your Life Group to grow in faith, or to rejoice at God's grace to them?
