 - b. "I come to church when I can, but life is so busy these days".
 - c. "I just feel I'm too much of a hypocrite to walk into to church".
 - d. "I don' talk to X (at church), they have hurt me too badly".

Close by spending some time praying about our studies that they would be life changing for us as individuals and as a body.
