- 2) Praying Acts 1:14 1 Tim 2:8
- 3) Speaking 1 Cor 11:5 Col 3:16
- 4) Teaching Titus 2:3 Acts 18:26

- 1. Looking at Eph 4:12-16, how does this passage speak about "every member ministry"? What does that mean for you?
- 2. Have a skim through Romans 16. How does this chapter expand your view of men's and women's ministry? Does it raise any questions? [do store Q's for next Wednesday 1st Oct].
- 3. What advice would you give to someone who is not sure where to "get stuck in" at church? Do you anticipate any changes to your formal serving roles at church this term? What informal roles must we also remember? Can you think of ways you can love and serve your fellow lifegroup members better?
- 4. [If time... Read ahead to 1 Timothy 2:8-15, the passage that we will be looking at next Sunday. Do you think Paul's comments to women are demeaning to women? Do you think they refer to a local problem in Ephesus or contain timeless universal principles?]

### A couple of (expanded) terms...

- "Complementarianism" the theological idea that men and women have different and complementary roles in the home and the church.
  - [NB The verb to complement is different from the verb to compliment. When you are complimentary to someone, you say that their shirt looks nice. You can also do both by complimenting them that their shirt looks nice and it complements (matches together well with) their hairstyle! For more on the secular usage of both words see Merriam Webster here].
- "Egalitarianism" the theological idea that there are no distinctions between the roles men and women can take in the home and the church.
